LEARNING OUTCOMES

Animal Behavior

- Students observe and mimic a wide variety of animal survival behaviors as they make their way throughout the various habitats in the park.
- A ride on the Kilimanjaro Safaris® attraction provides students an introduction to African wildlife while giving them an opportunity to observe, categorize, and analyze data on a wide variety of animal behaviors.
- Students journey through the Maharajah Jungle Trek® attraction while discovering how the natural adaptations of animals help them to survive in their surroundings.
- Students learn that although human behavior can certainly strain the resources of a particular ecosystem, it can also serve to aid those same resources if the right behaviors are demonstrated.

Social Structures and Survival

- By focusing on natural behaviors, students experience some of the greatest challenges to the survival of animal species from around the world.
- While actively observing animals throughout Disney's Animal Kingdom Theme Park, students compare the social structures of animals from all around the world to those animals found within the lands of the park.
